## A Brief History of Council #1394

The Council received its charter on March 29, 1909. There were 53 charter members. The first Grand Knight was M.J. McCaron and the first Chaplain was Reverend



Denis Morris. There have been 52 Grand Knights and 9 Chaplains. The Council first met at the Cathedral of St. Catherine of Alexandria on Church Street until the early 1940's when property was purchased at 149 King Street where Carlisle Street is now. In early 1977, this property was expropriated by the City of St. Catharines.

The Council then moved to the Holy Childhood building on Wellington Street

at Lake Street. In July of 1979, we moved to our present location at 235 Church Street. Council #1394 was the first Council in the Niagara Region.

It was followed by #1652 Niagara Falls in 1912, #2319 Thorold in 1921, #4917 Grimsby in 1960, Thorold #2319 reactivated in 1979, #7741 Pere Edmund (French) in 1981, #8378 St. Mary's in 1983 and Cathedral Council #9222 in 1985.

At one time, our Council had 2 First Degree teams, 1 Second Degree team and 1 Third Degree Team. The Council also sponsored a Columbian Squires Circle #1251. The Circle was very active.
